Scripture Lesson: Psalm 99 (A Women's Lectionary for the Whole Church, Wilda C. Gafney)

The EVER-LIVING GOD reigns; let the people tremble! She sits enthroned upon the cherubim; let the earth quake! 2 The HOLY ONE OF OLD is great in Zion; she is exalted over all the peoples. 3 Let them praise your great and awesome name. Holy is she! 4 Mighty Majesty, lover of justice, you have established equity; you have executed justice and righteousness among the descendants of Rebekah. 5 Extol the MOTHER OF CREATION, our God; bow down and worship at her footstool. Holy is she! 6 Moses and Aaron were among her priests (Miriam her prophet), Samuel (and Hannah) also among those who called on her name.
