Scripture Lesson: Exodus 20:1-4, 7-9, 12-20

Then God spoke all these words: **2** I am the Holy One your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery; **3** you shall have no other gods before me. **4** You shall not make for yourself an idol, whether in the form of anything that is in heaven above, or that is on the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. ...

7 You shall not make wrongful use of the name of the Holy One your God, for the Holy One will not acquit anyone who misuses the name of God. 8 Remember the sabbath day, and keep it holy. 9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work. ...

Scripture Lesson: Psalm 19

The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims God's handiwork. **2** Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declares knowledge. **3** There is no speech, nor are there words; their voice is not heard; **4** yet their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In the heavens God has set a tent for the sun, **5** which comes out like a bridegroom from his wedding canopy, and like a strong man runs its course with joy. **6** Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them; and nothing is hid from its heat.

7 The law of the Holy One is perfect, reviving the soul; the decrees of the Holy One are sure, making wise the

simple; 8 the precepts of the Holy One are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Holy One is clear, enlightening the eyes; 9 the fear of the Holy One is pure, enduring forever; the ordinances of the Holy One are true and righteous altogether. 10 More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey, and drippings of the honeycomb. 11 Moreover by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward. 12 But who can detect their errors?
