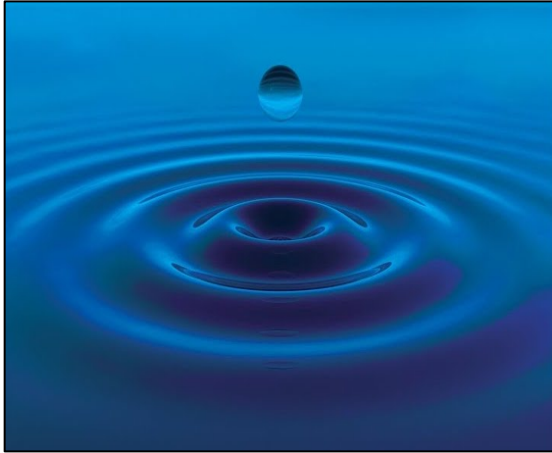

Scripture Lesson: Psalm 46

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. **2** Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change, though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea; **3** though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble with its tumult. **4** There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High. **5** God is in the midst of the city; it shall not be moved; God will help it when the morning dawns. **6** The nations are in an uproar, the kingdoms totter; (God) utters (God's) voice, the earth melts. **7** The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. **8** Come, behold the works of the LORD; see what desolations (God) has brought on the earth. **9** (God)

Scripture Lesson: Luke 23:33-43

When they came to the place that is called The Skull, they crucified Jesus there with the criminals, one on his right and one on his left. **34** Then Jesus said, "(My God), forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." And they cast lots to divide his clothing. **35** And the people stood by, watching; but the leaders scoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Messiah of God, (God's) chosen one!" **36** The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine, **37** and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!" **38** There was also an inscription over him, "This is the King of the Jews."

39 One of the criminals who were hanged there kept deriding him and saying, "Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us!" **40** But the other rebuked him, saying, "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? **41** And we indeed have been condemned justly, for we are getting what we deserve for our deeds, but this man has done nothing wrong." **42** Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." **43** He replied, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in Paradise."
