

Scripture Lesson: Psalm 66:8-20 (The Message – adapted) 8-12 Bless our God, O peoples! Give God a thunderous welcome! Didn't God set us on the road to life? Didn't God keep us out of the ditch? God trained us first, passed us like silver through refining fires, brought us into hardscrabble country, pushed us to our very limit, roadtested us inside and out, took us to hell and back; finally God brought us to this well-watered place.

13-15 I'm bringing my prizes and presents to your house. I'm doing what I said I'd do, what I solemnly swore I'd do that day when I was in so much trouble: the choicest cuts of meat for the sacrificial meal; even the fragrance of roasted lamb is like a meal!
